#	Decision
D18-3	Update 2030 target statement to reference “accessible and convenient” in place of “gasoline-like experience”. Keep the reference to “achieving market conditions” somewhere in neighboring text.
D18-4	Support development of 1-2 pager summary of Vision 2030 document with GO Biz by May 31 <sup>st</sup> to support outreach to legislature during ongoing budget discussions. Priority project to support \$92M hydrogen station funding. Develop as shared stakeholder talking points and facilitate industry stakeholders to get to Capitol to reinforce messages and need for state support for hydrogen infrastructure and success requirements for all ZEVs. Develop outreach game plan.
D18-5	Send word version of next 2030 Vision draft to EB and ST this week for content review, use that draft to insert into design layout options as ‘near final’ text. Solicit member feedback on design expectations and desires, and use this feedback to support simultaneous development of in-house and possible external design of document.
D18-6	Solicit member feedback on expectations, needs and direction – with draft 2030 Vision content in mind – for developing implementation plans for state and national rollout, considering future discussions with H2USA and its members.
